According to the International Baccalaureate Program Guide:

- The Extended Essay is a piece of independent research on a topic chosen by the student:
- Diploma Students begin their EE during their junior year, and it is due in early February of their senior year.
- Certificate Students begin their EE during their junior year, and it is due in November of their senior year
*** Diploma Students will have a Mentoring Teacher at SM East ${ }^{* *}$
- It is presented as a formal piece of sustained academic writing containing no more than:
- Diploma Students $=\mathbf{4 , 0 0 0}$ words
- Certificate Students $=\mathbf{2 , 0 0 0}$ words

It is the result of approximately 40/20 hours of work by the student.
